About the Journal: The INTESOL JOURNAL (ITJ) is a professional journal published by the Indiana Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages (INTESOL). ITJ encourages the submission of previously unpublished articles on topics of significance to individuals concerned with the teaching of language. The journal accepts and publishes original articles primarily in the research and practice of the teaching English to speakers of other languages, which include K-12, university and adult ESL education settings. ITJ prefers that all submissions be written so that their content is accessible to a broad readership, including individuals who may not have a familiarity with the subject matter addressed.

General Procedures

- Contributors of full-length articles are strongly encouraged to submit manuscripts ranging from 10-20 double-spaced pages in Microsoft Word. Please put all figures and tables in place in the text (rather than at the end). Number and title all figures and tables. Articles should conform generally to the American Psychological Association (5th Edition) format.
